Timothy Alan Simon was appointed to the California Public Utilities Commission by Governor Schwarzenegger on February 15, 2007. A former securities and banking industry attorney, he actively promotes and encourages diversity in utility procurement, educational opportunities, and the workplace. Prior to the CPUC, Commissioner Simon was the Appointments Secretary to Governor Schwarzenegger, the first African American in California history to hold that post.

Commissioner Simon is Chair of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) Committee on Natural Gas, a member of NARUC's Board of Directors, and various other committees. Locally, Commissioner Simon serves on several non-profit boards, including the Saint Ignatius College Preparatory Board of Regents, San Francisco Bay Catholic Charities/CYO and the Megan Furth Catholic Academy.
